Treasurer's Report

Rose Abrahams distributed an income/expenses report which contained a summary of transactions for the month and year to date. For the year, we have had a total of \$25,914.32 in income, and \$17,939.70 in expenses, resulting in a net gain of \$7,974.62. Anyone interested in a detailed report may contact Rose or Denise Dallman. Denise reported that the SLBC will not need to pay Kansas taxes, as long as we continue to support academic interests of the high school. SLBC will be recognized as a PTO by the State.

Fundraisers

- Baseball hats are still being sold for \$24. If someone paid \$25, they can get a dollar back. There was some confusion about the selling price.
- Baseball, softball, and track t-shirts are being pre-ordered.
- A suggestion was made to be sure to inform coaches in advance that Booster Club will be ordering t-shirts for all major sports, so that the profit can be turned back into the student activities. Most of the products that SLBC sells, generate a \$3-5 profit.

Spirit Boosters

- March/April student activities supported:
 - Forensics Tournament – a supply of water and snacks were available to Mrs. Naylor to distribute at several of the tournaments
 - Vocal and Band State contest – donuts and juice during class
 - Junior High Play Cast – pizza during rehearsal
- Several requests have been made; all were approved once more information could be gathered.
 - State Assessments for Junior High – Since we were a little behind schedule, a healthy snack and drink will be provided during science and social studies assessments. It was suggested that next year we be a little more proactive and ask parents to bring snacks.
 - State Assessment reward for High School – Pizza will be ordered for students after the first week in May (after the lunch period) as a reward for doing well on the assessments.
 - State Journalism – money for lunch was requested; Rose will find out the date this is needed.
 - Junior High Counselor, Mrs. Fleming, McDonald's reward program – Lynette will find out how much money is being requested – part or whole?

- FFA, Mr. Blush, would like 3 blue jackets for students to wear during judging; Lynette will get more information on this as well.
- Baseball, softball, track – goody bags or meal money closer to Regionals.
- Golf – Even though the bags were purchased, goody bags will still be made. Dena will work on this.
- Junior High Track – Julie and Ruth will put together goody bags for the Mill Creek Valley meet on May 2.

Other Business

- Activity Pass Proposal – Denise attended the majority of the Board of Education meeting and there was no mention of the Activity Pass. The administration will be contacted again, as the officers had presented a formal proposal to them several months ago.
- Scholarship – In support of our mission to assist in academics at SLHS, two \$350 scholarships will be made available to graduating seniors. After some discussion, the application will read: “Any student who meets the following minimum requirements is eligible for the scholarship. Names will be randomly drawn from the submitted applications. Please return the application to Mr. Kramer by May 2, 2008. Minimum Requirements: 3.20 cumulative GPA (as of the end of 1st semester, senior year), and participation in 2 extra-curricular activities for each year attending Silver Lake High School. (This includes athletics, music, debate, forensics, FFA, etc.)” Mr. Kramer agreed to distribute and collect the applications. It was suggested that we look into how other organizations ensure that the money is spent on college expenses.
- After Prom – Help is still needed for Friday night setup and the night of After Prom. Contact Kristi or Lynette if you can help.
